It was therefore a good decision not to set up the  $2 \times 17$  element long yagis by M2, but instead stuck again with the smaller  $2 \times 8$  element DK7ZB as we already did in May and July. The retractable Flammex Pull, which is built into the radio bus, was used as the antenna mast.

The DX conditions were average for the most time. Towards midnight it was still best to the south-east direction. But by Sunday we had normal conditions again.

Overall, we were very lucky with the weather. On Saturday it was very nice all day and, thanks to our altitude of 560 metres, not as hot as in the valley. Only on Sunday morning was there a brief spell of light rain. The heavy areas of rain on Sunday afternoon passed us further to the west. It therefore remained dry during dismantling.

The result was nowhere near as good as the year before in September 2023. But we were able to improve our result slightly compared to the July contest.






