It was therefore a good decision not to set up the 2 x 17 element long yagis by M2, but instead stuck again with the smaller 2 x 8 element DK7ZB as we already did in May and July. The retractable Flammex Pull, which is built into the radio bus, was used as the antenna mast.

The DX conditions were average for the most time. Towards midnight it was still best to the south-east direction. But by Sunday we had normal conditions again.

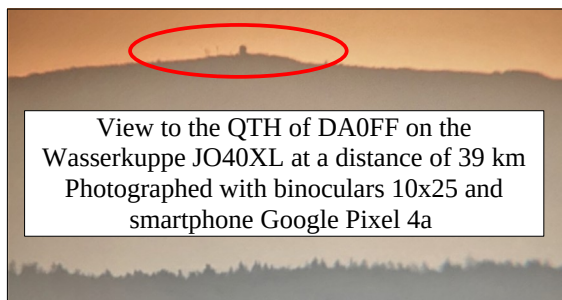

The result was nowhere near as good as the year before in September 2023. But we were able to improve our result slightly compared to the July contest.

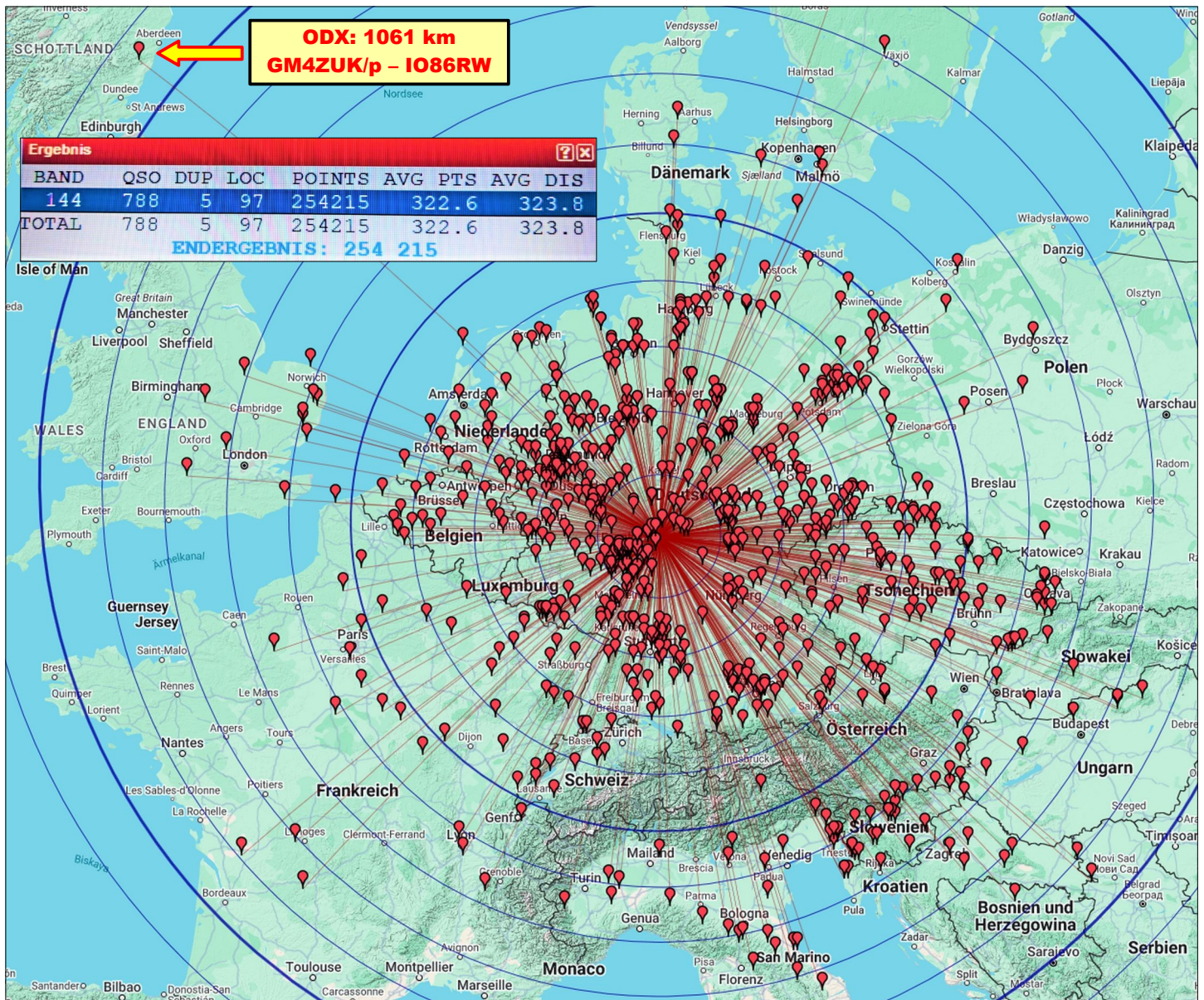
